Water and Sanitary Sewer Projects

Design is underway to rehabilitate and expand the Taylorcrest Water Plant in 2016. This plant is located north of Taylorcrest at Flintdale. This project will ensure we have sufficient water available during peak usage periods and allow a more flexible use of the water production facilities. Design should be completed in the summer with construction to begin in late 2016. Construction completion is scheduled for Spring 2017.

In addition, \$1 Million has been allocated to replace water lines and \$500,000 to replace sanitary sewer lines at various locations throughout the city. These old sanitary sewers are made out of cast iron and the wastewater lines are concrete. They will be replaced with PVC pipe which will last for 80+ years.

This is the first phase of a multi-year ~ multi-million dollar investment in our utility system.



Memorial Bridge Reconstruction April to August 2016 *Memorial Drive to be Closed*

Memorial Drive will be closed from April to August, 2016 to reconstruct the bridge across W151. This timeframe was selected to accommodate the school schedule for Frostwood and Bunker Hill Elementary Schools. Memorial Drive will be reopened in time for the new school year in August.

Traffic will be detoured via Briar Forest on the south, Barry Knoll on the north connected by Gessner Road on the west.

We have been working with the Police and Fire Departments to ensure there is no negative impact to Public Safety. Local traffic will always have access.


Drainage Improvements

The City Council is working with the Drainage Committee to identify priorities for Drainage needs in the City. Funding in the amount of \$750,000 has been allocated for 2016.

Piney Point Drainage Improvements January to August 2016

The City of Piney Point will begin a major drainage project in early January 2016. The City will be installing a large box culvert storm sewer under the Memorial Drive/Blalock intersection and south on Piney Point Road. This project is estimated to take 8 months and will impact the traffic flow at Memorial/Blalock and South Piney Point Road.
