

Mechanical Electrical Plumbing

Important Permit Considerations

- All contractors must meet the licensing requirements of the State of Texas.
- All work will be required to meet or exceed the International Residential Code 2018 and the National Electric Code 2020.
- All Contractors are required to be registered with the City of Bunker Hill Village to obtain a permit.
 All State required licenses must be current and a valid certificate of insurance must be provided to the City for registration. There is no fee to register.
- If your work is part of a project by a General Contractor, the General Contractor must obtain his permit first. Your permit fees will be determined by the type of project the General Contractor permits. For example, if a Room Addition permit is issued to a General Contractor, all sub-contractor permits will be for a Room Addition.
- Any mechanical, electrical, or plumbing systems exposed as a part of a remodel project will be required to meet current code requirements.
- All Projects not part of a larger project can be permitted based on the current adopted City Permit Fee Schedule. Please see the link below to register and apply for these types of permits.

Electrical

The City of Bunker Hill has adopted the 2020 National Electrical Code as produced by NFPA70.

- a. All wiring shall meet all requirements outlined in this code.
- b. All services supplying dwelling units must meet Article 230.67 Surge Protection
- IN ADDITION, the City allows ONLY copper conductors beyond the electric meter.
 NO ALUMINUM CONDUCTORS ALLOWED.
- d. If the electrical panel is replaced, incoming electrical service must be underground from the point of service from CenterPoint.
- e. CenterPoint Energy Service Standards
