II. PUBLIC HEARING

Radford Laney of 333 Bunker Hill, said there has been a tremendous increase in traffic on Bunker Hill Road because of the construction around Memorial City and asked that the City approach Metro National to help pay for the reconstruction of Bunker Hill Road.

Marcus Tucker of 226 Stoney Creek, said that city council should be good stewards of the reserves being set up for street and road replacement and that it only be used for street and road replacement.
