CRIME ANALYSIS SUMMARY

BUNKER HILL

On 12/06/13 at 9:35 am, officers took a report of harassment in the 11600 block of Memorial Dr. The victim is being harassed by telephone from her ex-husband.

On 12/06/13 at 3:00 pm, officers took a report of a theft of an air conditioning unit from a vacant house in the 11700 block of Long Leaf.

On 12/08/13 officers took a report of a criminal mischief on Bradfield Court. The victim reported that someone shot out his porch light with a bb or pellet gun.

CRIME PREVENTION TIPS

As we end one year and begin a new one we will spend the next few weeks reviewing the prevention and safety tips dealing with home, vehicle and financial crime prevention. This week will focus on home security recommendations.

ALWAYS keep all exterior doors and windows to your home locked at ALL times. This includes the overhead garage door any time that you are not in the garage.

If your residence has a fence that encloses the back yard keep the gates locked to prevent unauthorized persons from entering this area of your property.

If your home has an alarm system, ALWAYS set the alarm at night or when you are away from home, even for a short period of time. It is also recommended that you have a motion detector in the master bedroom suite since this is where many valuables are kept.

DO NOT leave lawn equipment, bicycles or sporting good equipment (golf clubs etc..) out in plain sight. ALWAYS keep them locked in a secure storage area when not in use.

Exterior lighting that is controlled by a photoelectric cell is also an excellent home security tool. This type of lighting comes on automatically at dark and turns off automatically in the daytime, so that it does not advertise when you are away from home. This type of lighting is extremely effective for driveway areas where vehicle are left parked outside of garages.

When driving home, especially at night, be aware of your surroundings and watch for any vehicles that might be following you. Also be observant when arriving home for anything unusual such as unfamiliar vehicles parked with people sitting in them.
