This has been a topic of discussion and oversight for many years as a result of the geographical location of the existing Fire Station.

As we continue to see traffic increase in the area and in the Village, the City is committed to ensure our public safety access is not compromised for our residents.

We are currently working with a consultant to see how best to approach this challenge. We are hopeful we can continue to work with the Village Fire Department to address our concerns.

Dear Residents,

The City Council has begun the annual budget process preparing for Fiscal Year (Calendar Year) 2019. The Council has reviewed the proposed budget and supports maintaining the tax rate at \$0.277 per \$100 in valuation. There is a proposed increase in utility rates offset by the reduced costs for trash and recycling. As Mayor Williams states, public safety is our top priority. The budget continues to focus on Fire, EMS and Police as well as our public infrastructure: water, wastewater, drainage and streets.
