

Capital Improvement Projects – Project Updates

We are pleased to update you on our Capital Improvement Projects:

- Construction is underway with our Regional Drainage Project for the area of Taylorcrest, Williamsburg, Bunker Hill Road and Cobblestone West. Taylorcrest is open with drainage work completed. There are still some lane closures during the day as the contractor completes the restoration on Taylorcrest. There is much progress being made on Bunker Hill Road. Keep an eye out for our northbound only Bunker Hill traffic to be moving to the western side of the roadway. Traffic continues northbound only until Bunker Hill is complete.
- Construction continues on our Water Line Project in the upper area of Blalock Road and adjacent cul-de-sacs. Wendover Lane is complete.
- City Council has approved the final design contract for Kilts, Warrenton and Valley Star Street Improvements. Construction for this project is planned to begin in the Summer of 2019.
