

Capital Improvement Projects -- Your Tax Dollars at Work

We are pleased to update you on our Capital Improvement Projects:

- The City just completed our second wastewater rehabilitation project. The area included the side streets along Strey Lane and Knipp Road and other priority areas.
- The City completed construction at the Taylorcrest Water Plant. We added new storage at this location to improve water pressures and supply. We also added extensive landscaping and fence work to be a good neighbor to our adjacent residents and to help beautify this area. *Thank you to our Beautification Committee.*
- Construction is underway with our Regional Drainage Project for the area of Taylorcrest, Williamsburg, Bunker Hill Road and Cobblestone West. Our contractor has already made great progress on Taylorcrest. They have informed us that they will be moving to Bunker Hill Road in mid July. As a result, we have developed the traffic control plan below for the time when one lane of Taylorcrest (eastbound) remains closed as we close southbound Bunker Hill Road. Please note: Both lanes on Taylorcrest and the sidewalk will be opened when school starts back in August.

You may be seeing some trees flagged along Bunker Hill Road. We are working with our arborist to flag trees for removal. Most trees noted for removal are not only problematic for the project but mainly, they are not in good health and need to be removed.

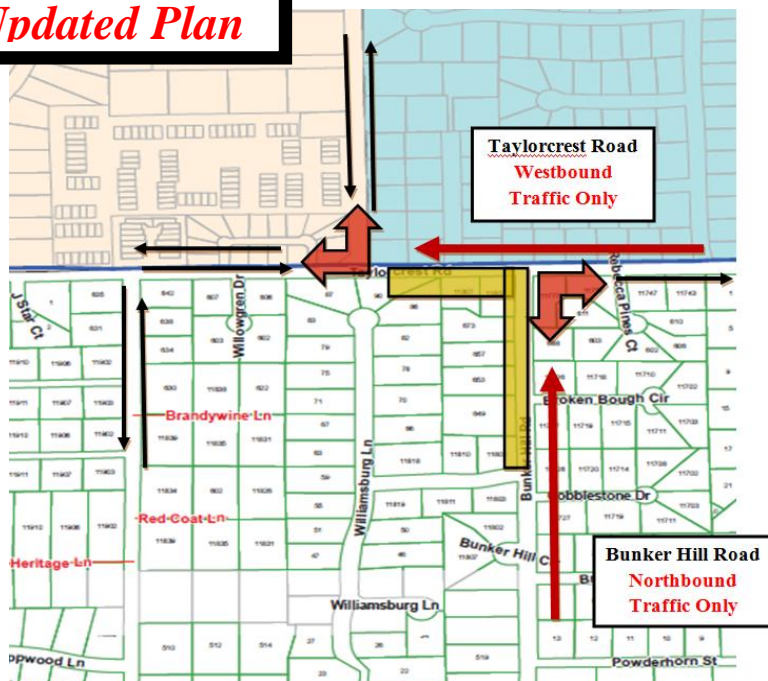
Many thanks to the City's Drainage Committee for their leadership on this project and with other improvements planned for other areas.
