III. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING A RECOMMENDATION TO THE CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE A FINAL PLAT FOR 8 VALLEY FORGE – Karen Glynn, Acting City Secretary/ Community Development

Karen Glynn, Acting City Secretary/Community Development, presented the item:

A Preliminary Plat for this property was presented to the Commission on January 24, 2023. The Commission recommended that the platting process move forward to the next step with the submission of a Final Plat.

Plans for construction of a new home at 8 Valley Forge were submitted for review. During the plan review process, it was found that no final plat was ever recorded with Harris County. The property does not qualify for a short form final plat as the property does not lie within an existing public street circulation. Valley Forge is considered a private street.

Staff, as well as the City's platting consultant, reviewed the Final Plat and found the plat meets all requirements of the City's Ordinances. Staff recommended that the Planning and Zoning Commission recommend approval to the Council for the Final Plat.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gillette and seconded by Commissioner Muschalik to approve a final plat at 8 Valley Forge.

- B. Drainage Committee Review on Synthetic Turf
 - The City has received requests to lay synthetic turf. City Staff will meet with the Drainage Committee to review the use of synthetic turf and how it will work in conjunction with the City's Code of Ordinances, specifically the drainage ordinance.
