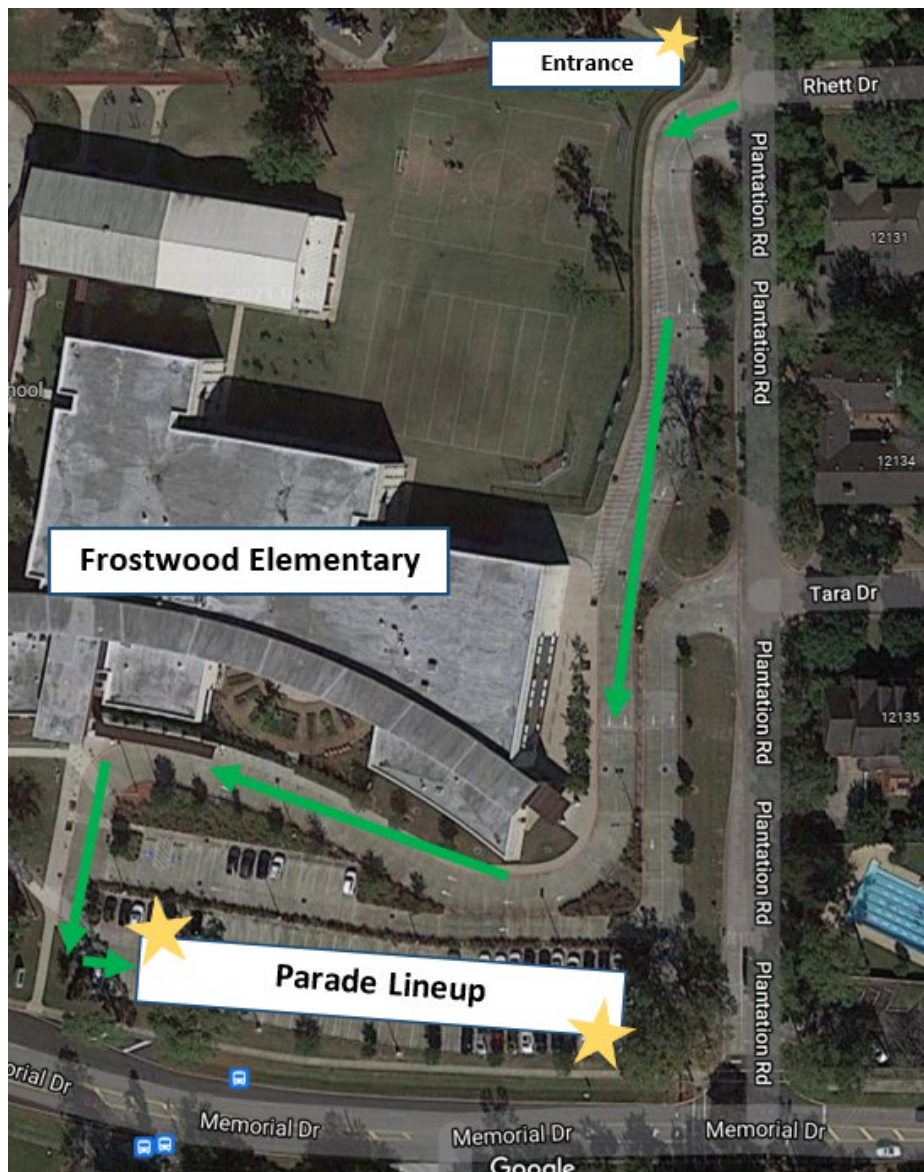

SCHEDULE

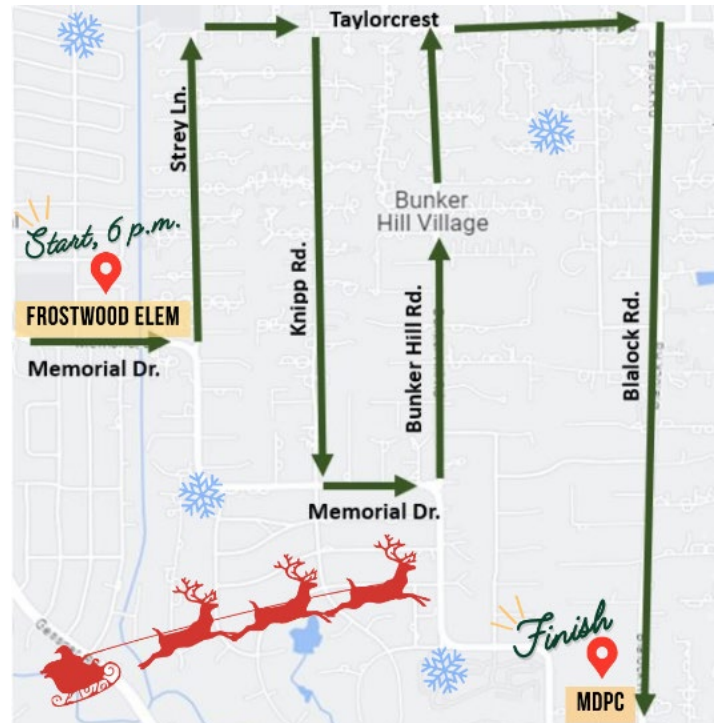
PARADE START/ LINEUP

- Parade lineup begins at 5:15 p.m. in the Frostwood Elementary parking lot facing Memorial Drive (12214 Memorial Dr. Houston, TX 77024). **Please arrive no later than 5:45 p.m.**
- Enter the parking lot from Plantation (see map below).
- You will receive an email on Tuesday, December 17 with your assigned parade color for lineup.
- **Parade begins promptly at 6:00 p.m.**



PARADE ROUTE

- Parade will start at Frostwood Elementary and finish at Memorial Drive Presbyterian Church (MDPC) (11612 Memorial Dr. Houston, TX 77024).



PARADE END/ HOLIDAY CELEBRATION

- Parade will arrive at MDPC by 7:30 p.m. for a holiday celebration – pictures with Santa, snow, a balloon artist, cookie decorating, & hot chocolate (while supplies last)!
- **Turn right from Blalock Rd. into MDPC and park in your assigned parade color line as lineup.**
- Event concludes at 8:30 p.m.

PARTICIPANT RULES AND GUIDELINES

- This is a lighted night-time parade, all entries should be well lit and decorated to fit a holiday, winter theme.
- **NO TOSSING CANDY, BEADS, TOYS, ETC. TO THE CROWD.**
- Playing music with vulgar lyrics and/ or profanity is not allowed.
- No jumping on or off floats/ vehicles.
- **NO WALKERS – VEHICLES ONLY.**

- Keep one (1) car length distance between you and the entry in front of you.
- Smoking and the use and/ or possession of alcohol, firearms, and any illegal substances are prohibited during the parade at all times.
- This is a family-friendly holiday event; all participants shall conduct themselves in a courteous and respectful manner. Any signage shall also be courteous and respectful.
